Keep humidity levels high, temperatures above 60°F (15°C), and fertilize monthly during the growing season. There are five species of bird of paradise plants. These flowering plants are native to South Africa, where they are also called crane flowers. Some species of *Strelitzia* can grow to 32 ft. (10 m) tall.

Under the right conditions, including full, southern light exposure, proper humidity and temperature, Bird of Paradise may flower indoors, although this is rare. Bird of paradise can also be propagated from seed; however, blooming will not begin for at least five years. Container and in-ground plants have the same pest and disease issues.

The easiest way to propagate bird of paradise is through division. Dividing bird of paradise plants is best accomplished on mature plants that have been previously blooming for at least three years.

Birds-of-paradise build their nests from soft materials, such as leaves, ferns, and vine tendrils, typically placed in a tree fork. The typical number of eggs in each clutch varies among the species and is not known for every species. The Bird of Paradise (*Strelitzia reginae*) grows best when it receives a minimum of four hours of direct sunlight a day, but they should have bright light all day. Daytime temperatures of 68°-72° and night temperatures of 50° to 55° are optimal.
