Burial benefits. Someone who pays expenses for the burial of an employee may be able to get burial benefits if the employee died because of a work-related injury. The person who has the expenses must contact the insurance carrier in writing within twelve months of the date of death and attach copies of all related bills.

VA burial allowances are partial reimbursements of an eligible Veteran's burial and funeral costs. When the cause of death is not service related, the reimbursements are generally described as two payments: a burial and funeral expense allowance, and a plot or interment allowance. A single payment is made when the cause of death is service related.

The veteran's family or representative can apply for a veterans burial allowance (or veterans death benefit), in certain cases. These include veterans receiving a VA pension or compensation. The burial allowance can help pay for burial, funeral, and transportation costs. It can't be used for cremation, which is a funeral director service.

You must file a claim for a non-service-connected burial allowance within 2 years after the Veteran's burial or cremation. If a Veteran's discharge was changed after death from dishonorable to another status, you must file for an allowance claim within 2 years after the discharge update.

Increasing the burial allowance from \$900 to \$1,700 and increasing the cap on burial costs from \$1,700 to \$3,400. Extending the timeframe for when you can apply to 120 days from the date of the individual's death. Applications received on or after March 12, 2020 will be considered for the increased burial assistance allowance.
