Each State Engineering Board sets their own fee structure, education requirements, and other licensing guidelines. Generally, most require candidates to be attending or have graduated from an ABET accredited engineering program.

The Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) exam tests for a minimum level of competency in a particular engineering discipline. It is designed for engineers who have gained a minimum of four years' post-college work experience in their chosen engineering discipline. Listed below are the minimum requirements to be considered for admittance to the Principles and Practice of Engineering Examination: Education and Experience Requirements. An undergraduate engineering degree (4-year minimum) that has been accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Commission (EAC) of the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET) or that has been determined to be substantially equivalent to an EAC/ABET-accredited degree with 4 years of progressive engineering ...

The PE exam goes beyond testing academic knowledge and includes expertise gained in the practice of engineering. While no engineering experience is required to sit for the PE exam, NCEES statistics show that first-time examinees are more likely to pass the exam with at least four years of engineering experience.

The requirements cited in §14-305 (b, c or d) of the Business and Occupations Article, must be met before applying to take the Principles and Practice examination. All candidates for a Professional engineer's license must meet all required educational, experience and examination requirements.

A bachelor's or master's degree in engineering from a program accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Commission (EAC) of ABET. An acceptable result on the FE exam. Four years of acceptable work experience in the candidate's engineering discipline. An acceptable result on the PE exam in the candidate's discipline.
