The Community-based Care Transitions Program (CCTP), created by Section 3026 of the Affordable Care Act, tested models for improving care transitions from the hospital to other settings and reducing readmissions for high-risk Medicare beneficiaries. The goals of the CCTP were to improve transitions of beneficiaries from the inpatient hospital setting to other care settings, to improve quality ...

Program for All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE): This program coordinates and provides all needed preventive, primary, acute and long-term care services so that older people can continue living in the community. The emphasis is on enabling senior citizens to remain in their communities while enhancing their quality of life.

Home and community-based services are also known as waiver-funded services or waiver programs. The name waiver comes from the fact that the federal government "waives" medical assistance rules for institutional care in order for Pennsylvania to use the funds for HCBS.

What are the value-based programs? Value-based programs reward health care providers with incentive payments for the quality of care they give to people with Medicare. These programs are part of our larger quality strategy to reform how health care is delivered and paid for. Value-based programs also support our three-part aim:

### CMS' Value-Based Programs | CMS

Costs for assisted living generally range from \$2,000 to \$4,000 per month and vary depending on the size of living area, region of the state, and the amount of care needed. Individuals who meet certain service and care needs and meet established financial criteria may be eligible for Ohio's Assisted Living Waiver Program.

### HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED OPTIONS WAIVER

Thanks to new federal Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) rule, people who receive Medicaid HCBS will have the right to live in the most integrated setting and have full access to community living. Lifestyle decisions will be made with each person based on his or her preferences, also known as person-centered planning.

As mentioned above, CARE is a principle-based program designed to enhance the social dynamics in residential care settings through targeted staff development and ongoing reflective practice.

Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waivers A waiver is an extra set of Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program) benefits that you could qualify for in certain cases. These benefits can help you remain in your home and community. Waivers have extra program rules and some programs may have waitlists.

Home and community based services (HCBS) provide opportunities for Medicaid beneficiaries to receive services in their own home or community rather than institutions or other isolated settings. These programs serve a variety of targeted populations groups, such as people with intellectual or developmental disabilities, physical disabilities, and/or mental illnesses.
