Finally, Jean-François Champollion unravelled the mystery. He identified the name of Ptolemy V written on the Rosetta Stone, by comparing the hieroglyphs with the Greek translation. Then, he continued to study the names, using an obelisk from Philae (now in Dorset, England). The obelisk had the name of Ptolemy and Cleopatra written on it.

Similar to any other ancient language and script, the exact origin of the hieroglyphs is unknown and will most likely never be revealed in its entirety. For all we know, the oldest hieroglyphs found by archeologists that have been securely dated were from the period of Naqada II (3500 - 3200 BC) which makes this script no less than 5000 years old.

The History of Egyptian Hieroglyphs and the Rosetta Stone

The first attempt to decipher hieroglyphics, based on the assumption that they were indeed phonetic symbols, was made by the German scholar Athanasius Kircher in the mid-1600s. Despite his initial correct hypothesis, he correctly identified only one symbol.
