How to Force a Resolution in Windows Using the Registry ...

The last step is to actually change the screen resolution from the Control Panel and set it to 1078 x 768. After that the apps using the Metro interface should work fine. In case of problems, just reboot and press F8. Then select the Advanced Repair Options to start Windows in Safe Mode and restore the registry to the original settings. Then reboot and the screen should be fine again (although without the support for the 1078 x 768 resolution).

How to enable higher screen resolutions on Windows 8 ...

Windows 8 has a minimum resolution of 1024x768, unless you are running it in a VM. As such it doesn't support going into 1280x720 (since 720 < 768). Windows 7 allowed this, but the modes are missing from Windows 8. My video card and monitor support 1280x720. But it is missing from the slider:

On the desktop, right-tap any blank area and choose Screen resolution in the context menu. Step 2: Choose a proper resolution.
